

When Chef Tan was 25, his employer dismissed him upon learning that he was a former drug addict. Nicknamed the Iron Man Chef, the 48-year-old is now a celebrated culinary artist who is also a ceramics maker and avid triathlete.

Tan's father was a vegetable dealer and the death of his older brother and sister left him and his parents grieving. At 10, an infection left him mostly deaf in his left ear, and he struggled in school due to dyslexia. In secondary school, he fell into bad company and joined a gang which led him to experiment with drugs. Determined to turn his life around, Tan conquered his learning disability and worked hard at building his career.
